### **Membership Renewal Periods Clarified**

The inconsistency of PASR membership renewal periods is a cause of confusion for many members. I cannot explain why, but State membership and Local membership do not cover the same time frames.

### **Local Membership**

Everyone's local membership extends from July 1 to June 30. All local membership dues (\$15) are due on July 1.

### **State Membership**

Each member's State membership term is determined by the date of their original affiliation. If you paid your very first State dues on September 15, then your State dues (\$60) are payable on September 15 of each subsequent year. That date is indicated on the first line of the mailing label of your local newsletter. The exception to the rule for State membership is of course, Life membership. In that case your State dues have been paid. Life Membership is also indicated on the mailing label of your local newsletter.

## Community Service


### Salvation Army
